



## TEACHING COMPUTER SCIENCE AT NYC PUBLIC SCHOOLS

NYC Public Schools (NYCPS) offers many different opportunities for students to learn about computer science! While all NYCPS teachers must hold NYS teacher certification, prospective computer science teachers must meet specific certification requirements in order to teach the various computer science courses. This guidance document outlines the certification requirements for each computer science course and the pathways toward meeting them.
