What is an Internship Certificate?

An Internship Certificate is a two-year certificate for those who have completed at least 50% of an approved graduate program leading to an Initial Certificate.



Where can I teach with an Internship Certificate?

With a valid Internship Certificate or a letter from your school confirming that you are eligible for an Internship Certificate, you can apply to NYC Public Schools teaching positions in your certification area.

Citywide, there is the greatest need in these subject areas: English as a New Language, Science, Math, World Languages, Bilingual Education, and Students with Disabilities. In the Bronx and Brooklyn, there may also be a need for teachers in other subject areas.



How can I learn more about the program?
